## Implementation of ECCE State Curriculum

To enhance the implementation of Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) and strengthen the teaching-learning process across 1,931 Anganwadi centers in Raipur district, the ECCE State Curriculum is being rolled out in close coordination with all local stakeholders. Ongoing handholding support and skill development for Anganwadi workers are being facilitated through practical demonstrations. Furthermore, quality implementation is being ensured through regular field visits and focused micro-monitoring efforts.



## Orientation of CDPOs & Supervisors

A one-day orientation was held for 4 CDPOs and 38 Supervisors from Raipur Urban 02, Abhanpur, Tilda, and Dharsiwa 01, focusing on key components of the ECCE State Curriculum, Monthly Implementation Plan (MIP), ECCE Day, and monitoring and reporting practices from Phase 1 and 2. This session aimed to equip Supervisors to serve as Master Trainers for building the capacity of Anganwadi workers under Phase 2 of the 'Gadhbo Bachpan' project.
